Pupils Dress Code

This dress code has been written to ensure that all children are suitably attired in clothing that is fit for purpose and which instills a sense of belonging and corporate identity.

There are some items of clothing which we feel are inappropriate, or unsafe, in the school environment and we respectfully request that parents do not send children to school in these items.

Clothing which is not appropriate

- Jeans (or any 'jean' type trousers)
- Crop tops
- 'Spaghetti' strap tops
- Cargo pants
- Jogging bottoms
- 'Hoodies'
- 'Designer' clothing—in case it should be damaged or lost—this includes designer footwear.

It is requested that children wear the following items:

- Red school sweatshirt/Cardigan
- Navy or White Polo shirt
- Navy trousers/Skirt
- Red Gingham Summer dresses (Summer Term)
- Black shoes (black plimsolls for indoor use- please can parents ensure that these are in good condition and are a good fit. School will advise if any indoor shoes have become unsafe)

PE Lessons

- School PE t-shirt and black shorts
- Trainers

If children choose not to wear school PE kit, the clothing provided by parents must be fit for purpose. It is advised that 'designer' clothing is not used for this purpose.
